*Behaviour Supplement

To qualify for the highest level of the Behaviour Supplement, a dementia diagnosis, provisional dementia diagnosis, psychiatric diagnosis or behavioural diagnosis is required. In the case of diagnoses covering depression, psychotic and neurotic disorders (refer Mental and Behavioural Diagnoses codes 540, 550A, 550B, 560) the diagnosis, provisional diagnosis or re-confirmation of the diagnosis must have been completed within the **past 12 months**.
